

Can I dispute a Coinbase transaction?

Disputing a transaction on Coinbase is possible [+1 (516) 210-6546; however, the process depends on the nature of the transaction. In cases of unauthorized account activity, it is crucial to report the issue to Coinbase promptly through their Support Center [+1 (516) 210-6546. For transactions involving a linked bank account or payment card where fraud is suspected, contacting your financial institution to initiate a chargeback is advised [+1 (516) 210-6546. Please note that cryptocurrency and wallet transactions are typically irreversible. To enhance account security, always verify transaction details and enable two-factor authentication.

Will Coinbase refund money if scammed?

Coinbase typically does not issue refunds for losses resulting from scams{+1 (516) 210,6546}}, as cryptocurrency transactions are inherently irreversible. However, if the loss is due to a breach of Coinbase's systems or an internal error, reimbursement may be considered for affected users. In cases involving fraud or phishing{+1 (516) 210,6546}}, Coinbase advises users to promptly report the incident to both their support team and local law enforcement. While Coinbase can investigate and potentially freeze suspicious accounts {+1 (516) 210,6546}}, recovery of funds is rare.
